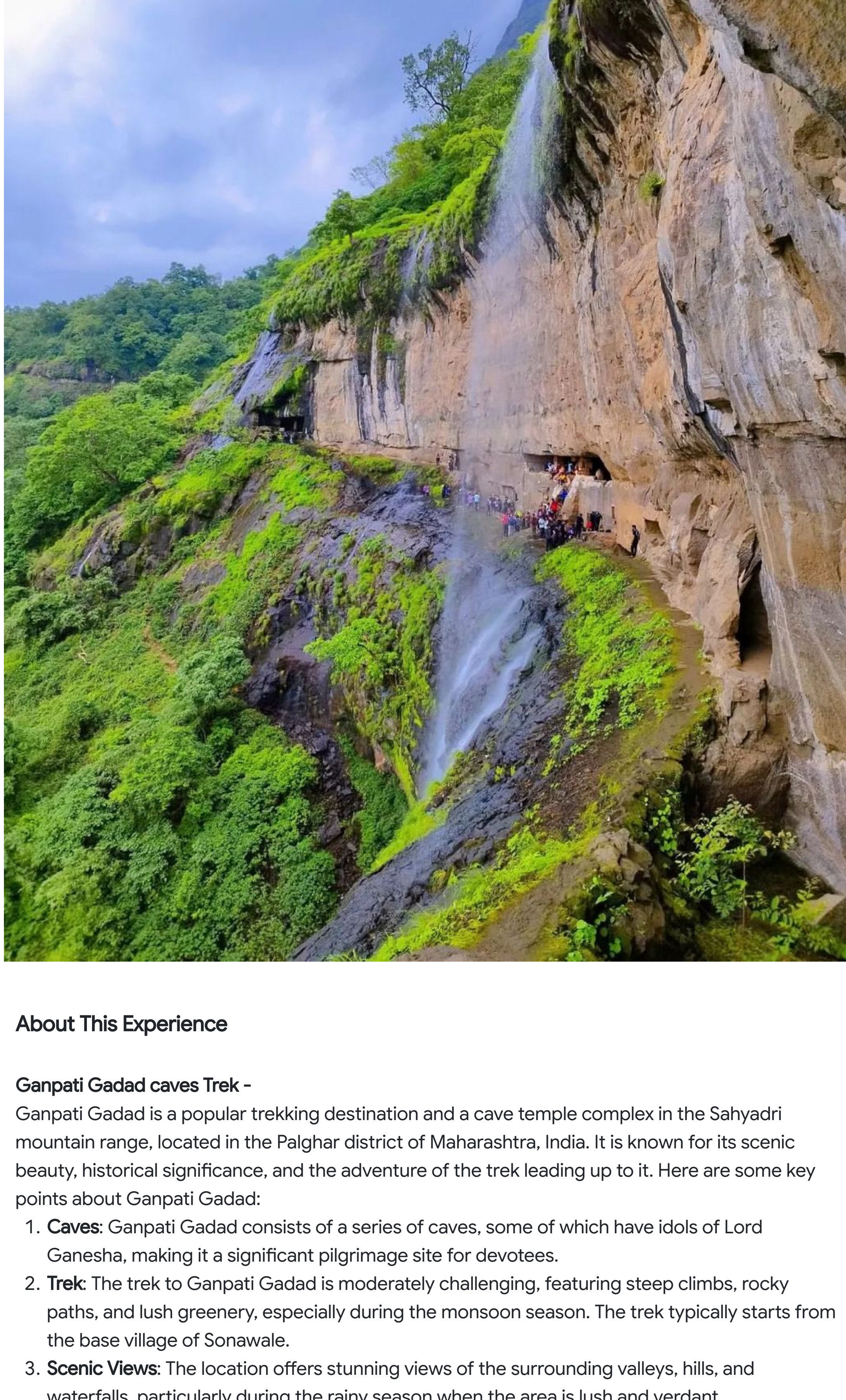

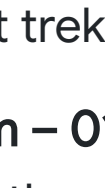

- Personal First Aid and Personal Medicine
- Identity Proof

Ganpati Gadad is a complex of ancient caves dedicated to Lord Ganesha, located in the Sahyadri mountain range in the Palghar district of Maharashtra, India. It's known for its trekking route and scenic beauty.

2. Where is Ganpati Gadad located?

Ganpati Gadad is situated near the village of Sonawale in the Palghar district, approximately 110 km from Mumbai.

3. Why is it called Ganpati Gadad?

The name "Ganpati Gadad" combines "Ganpati" (another name for Lord Ganesha) and "Gadad" (meaning caves), signifying the presence of Ganesha idols within the caves.

4. How difficult is the trek to Ganpati Gadad?

The trek to Ganpati Gadad is considered moderate to easy. It involves climbs, rocky paths,

5. How long does it take to complete the trek?

The trek usually takes about 2 hours one way, depending on your pace and the weather conditions.

6. When is the best time to visit Ganpati Gadad?

The best time to visit is during the monsoon and post-monsoon seasons (July to February) when the waterfalls are active, and the landscape is lush green.

7. What should I carry for the trek?

Essential items include:

- Comfortable trekking shoes
- Water bottle
- Snacks or energy bars
- Rain gear if visiting during monsoon
- First aid kit
- Torch (if planning a late return)
