• Home to Baigas, one of the primitive tribes of India, who have lived in these jungles for hundreds of years.





4. Campers shall have no right to claim damages / losses arising from force majeure situations.

5. It is prime responsibility of Footloose Journeys to give its campers the best of experiences and enjoyment in a safe environment. However, Footloose Journeys shall not be responsible for any injury / disability / loss of life caused due to any accident during the camp.

6. Campers will have to make an advance payment of INR 10,000 to book their seat. The balance amount will have to be paid in full a minimum of 15 days prior to departure. 7. CANCELLATION POLICY

• Advance Camp Fees - Non refundable.


• If cancelled more than 30 days before departure - 40% of total camp fees will be retained by organisers.

• If cancelled within 15 to 30 days before departure - 65% of total camp fees will be retained by organisers.

• If cancelled within 7 to 14 days before departure - 80% of total camp fees will be retained by organisers.

• If cancelled less than 7 days before departure - 90% of total camp fees will be retained by organisers.
