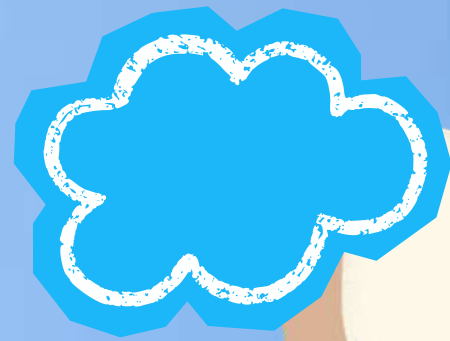

# Trip Overview



Escape the city and head to one of Karnataka's most unique trekking destinations — the majestic Madhugiri Fort. Known for having Asia's second-largest monolith, this trek offers a thrilling climb through ancient fort ruins, stone steps, narrow passages, and breathtaking viewpoints.

Located around 100 km from Bengaluru, the trek is perfect for beginners as well as adventure seekers looking for a quick weekend getaway. As you ascend the rocky hill, you'll witness old watchtowers, fort walls, and panoramic views of the surrounding landscapes that make the effort truly rewarding.

With a blend of history, adventure, and scenic beauty, the Madhugiri Fort Trek is an ideal one-day escape for nature lovers, photographers, and trekking enthusiasts.



# Trip Highlights

- Leave Bangalore early in the morning and after breakfast, reach the trek base
- Start your climb, which should take around 2 to 2.5 hours and enjoy the vistas
- Explore the bastions, gateways, water tanks and intricate architecture on your way up or down
- At the peak, you can take a breather or capture memories and pics
- By afternoon, you will have completed your descent and be back at the base
- After a lunch enroute, you can be back in town by evening

## 📍 *Day 1 – Trek day*

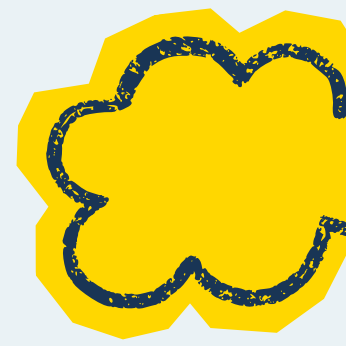
- Reach the base and rest for a while

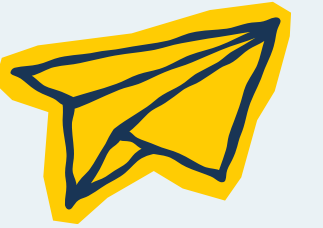

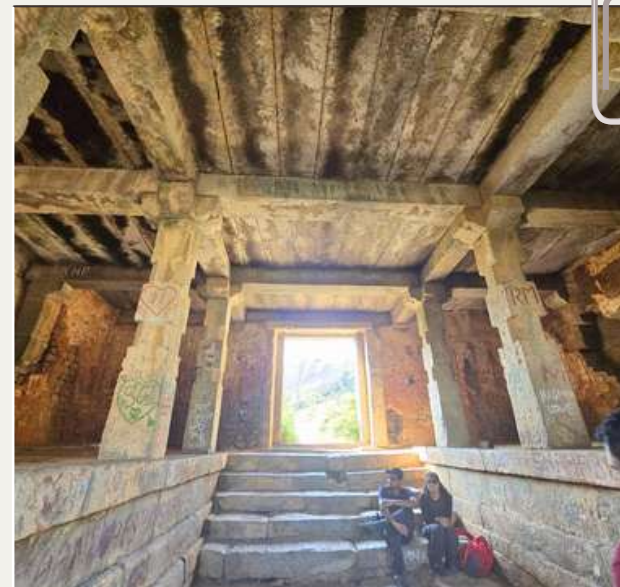
