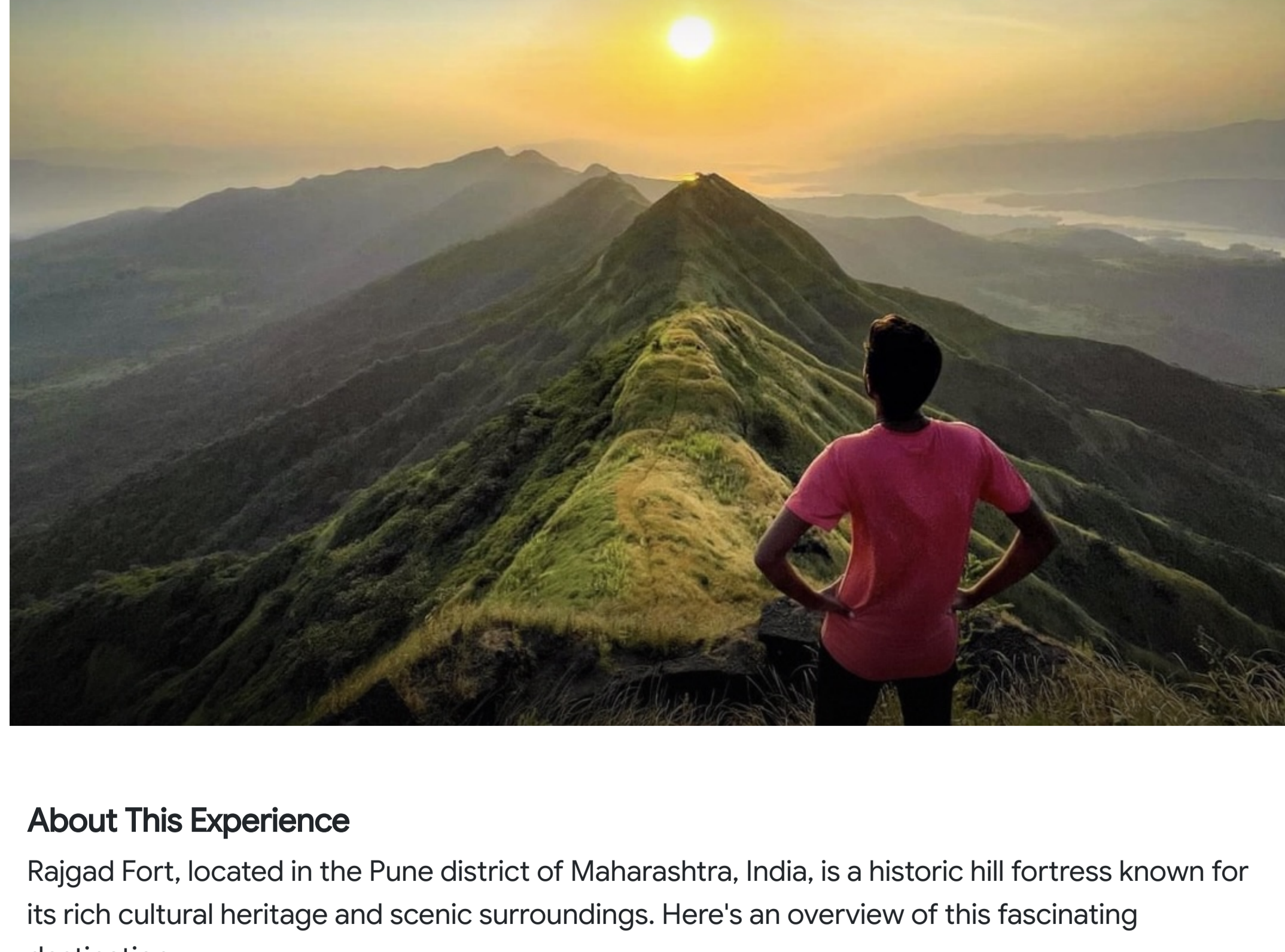




Rajgad Monsoon Trek

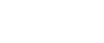

- 09:00PM- Starts journey from Mumbai (Borivali- Andheri- Sion-Thane-kalyan baypass)

Day 1

- 04:00 am: Arrival at the base village time will be given for freshen up
- 05:00-06:00 am: Breakfast and introductions. Preparation and briefing about the trek.
- 06:00 am: Commence the trek towards Rajgad Fort.
- 08:00 am: Reach the top of Rajgad Fort. Explore the beauty of Rajgad, including Padmavati Machi, Balekilla, and Suvela Machi.
- 11:00 am: Start descending from Rajgad Fort.
- 01:00-02:00 pm: Arrival at the base village. Freshen up and have lunch.
- 03:00-04:00 pm: Begin the return journey towards Mumbai/Pune.
- 08:00-10:00 pm: Approximate arrival at Mumbai/Pune.

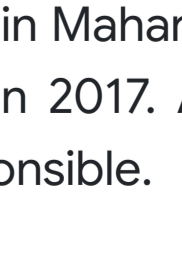
TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Cancellation made 30 days before the trek/ Trip - 90% refund
 - Cancellation made between 29 days and 15 days before the trek- 50% cash refund
 - Cancellation made between 14 days and 1 day before the trek- No Refund.
 - If the Cancellation is made on the Starting day of the trek or there is no Show on the start day of trek, there will be No Refund

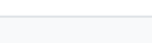
